

St. Francis de Sales School Uniform Dress Code

The purpose of having a uniform dress code is to ensure that students present themselves in a neat and uniform fashion, as to not disrupt the learning process. Therefore, clothes not from the uniform company **are not uniform**. Uniforms must be clean, neat, and hemmed properly.

A student's appearance is not to disrupt the learning environment. Wearing distractive jewelry, hair styles, hair color, hair length, or make-up will not be allowed and it will be brought to your attention so the situation may be remedied. There should not be any body piercing decorations with the exception of small earrings for the girls.

Students that are blatantly out of uniform will need to call parents to bring he/she the proper uniform or to take the student home.

The specific guidelines for appropriate school uniform attire are as follows:

Girls Grades K - 5

1. Uniform long navy blue shorts **with belt**. (Aug-Oct. & April - June).
2. Uniform plaid jumper, skirt or culottes (skorts) of **appropriate length and fit**.
3. Uniform yellow blouse. Nov. - March they may wear pale yellow turtleneck shirts with their uniforms. Shirt tails must be tucked inside.
4. Uniform dress slacks **with belt** may be worn.. (not jean type or cargo type pants)
5. Solid navy blue sweaters (no trim) may be worn.
6. **Only** sweatshirts with the St. Francis logo may be worn over a regular uniform shirt.. They are not to be tied around the students waist within the school building.
7. **Plain** socks, **not footies**, are to be worn (only plain white, navy or yellow)
We must be able to easily see socks above the shoes
or girls may wear navy or white **tights** (not panty hose).
8. Shorts may be worn under the uniform jumper, etc. BUT may not hang down beyond the hem of the jumper, etc.
9. Only solid white T-shirts or undergarments are to be worn under uniforms.
10. Girls may wear small earrings
(plain studs or small hoops...no large or dangling earrings).
11. Regular shoes are to be worn, sneakers, tennis shoes, dress shoes.
Please NO sandals or clogs or mules for safety reasons.

For all Students:

Snow boots may be worn by both boys and girls but they need to change into their regular school shoes upon arrival.

Coats and jackets may not be worn in the classrooms.

Boys in Grades K - 5

1. Uniform Navy blue pants. Aug.- Oct. & April - June they may wear uniform navy blue shorts. No jeans or cargo pants allowed.
2. Uniform pale yellow dress shirts or pale yellow knit shirts with a collar. No logos or emblems. Nov. - Mar. pale yellow turtleneck shirts may be worn.
3. Solid navy blue sweaters (no trim) may be worn.
4. Only sweatshirts with the St. Francis logo may be worn over a regular uniform shirt.. They are not to be tied around the students waist within the school building.
5. Belts are to be worn with both shorts and long pants.
6. Plain socks, **not footies**, are to be worn (only plain white, navy or yellow).
We must be able to easily see socks above shoes (even high top shoes).
7. Only solid white T-shirts are to worn under uniforms.
8. Shirt tails must be tucked in at all times.
9. Regular shoes are to be worn, sneakers, tennis shoes, dress shoes,.....please no sandals or clogs or mules for safety reasons.
10. Boys are not to have earrings or any other body piercing decorations.

For all Students:

Snow boots may be worn by both boys and girls but they need to change into their regular school shoes upon arrival.

Coats and jackets may not be worn in the classrooms.

Girls - Grade 6 & 7 & 8

Girls may wear khaki skirt, skort, long **uniform pants**.

They may wear long khaki uniform shorts in Aug. - Oct. and April - June.

All skirt, skorts, pants, or shorts should be of appropriate length coming close to knee length. and fit properly (not too tight or too short).

Girls may wear hunter green or maroon knit shirts. Shirt tails are to be tucked in at all times.

Girls may only wear school sweatshirts with the school emblem over a regular uniform shirt.. They come in hunter green and maroon. Sweat shirts are not to be tied around their waist within the school building.

Girls must wear a belt.

Girls may wear panty hose, tights, or plain socks (skin tone hose, white, maroon, hunter green socks or tights)

We should be able to easily see socks above shoes.

Girls may wear small earrings. No large hoops or other distracting jewelry.

Girls may not wear make-up.

Regular shoes are to be worn.....no sandals or clogs or mules for safety reasons.

Boys - Grade 7 & 8

Boys may wear khaki long **uniform pants**.

They may wear long khaki dress shorts in Aug. - Oct. and April - June.

Boys may wear hunter green or maroon knit shirts.

Boys may wear only school sweatshirts over regular uniform shirt. They come in hunter green and maroon. Sweatshirts are not to be tied around the students waist within the school building.

Belts must be worn with pants and shorts. Shirt tails must be tucked in.

Plain socks are to be worn (white, maroon, or hunter green)

We should be able to **easily see socks above shoes.**

Boys may not wear earrings or any other type of body piercing decorations.

Boys may not have letters, numbers, or symbols shaved in their haircut.

Regular shoes are to be worn.....no sandals or clogs or mules for safety reasons.

For all Students:

Snow boots may be worn by both boys and girls but they need to change into their regular school shoes upon arrival.

Coats and jackets may not be worn in the classrooms.
